



## U.S. gasoline price decreases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline decreased to \$3.29 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2.4 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$4.10 a gallon, up 5.1 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$2.84 a gallon, down 5.0 cents from a week ago.
