U.S. gasoline price increases (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline increased to \$3.17 a gallon on Monday. That's up 3.5 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$4.05 a gallon, up 2.0 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at \$2.74 a gallon, up 1.0 cents from a week ago.
